Dear Parent/Guardian,

This week marks the start of February but obviously not the end of our winter weather. To ensure the Health and Safety of our children I would be grateful if the following precautions are adhered to: -

- Unfortunately, not all closures can be predicted e.g. the failure of the heating boiler, when consequently the indoor temperature of the school can be a health risk to young children. In these unforeseen circumstances, the school endeavours to make the best decision for everyone concerned and regrettably whilst this may cause some inconvenience, we try to act in the best interest of the children.
