Parents have now been informed if they have been accepted into Ballysillan Primary School. We are absolutely delighted at all of our Nursery parents choosing our school. We are also delighted to welcome lots of new faces. New P1 parents, for the academic year September 2023, will be finding out who their P1 teacher is at the beginning of June. All children will then take part in our fantastic transition process. Children will get to take part in "Stay and Play" club in P1 one afternoon a week. The P1 teacher and assistant will also be in the Nursery playing with the children and reading stories. Via Seesaw parents will also receive lots of information and have time scheduled to speak to the P1 staff to share any extra information and concerns.
