Entering and Exiting the School

Due to child protection reasons **NO parents are allowed inside of the school building**. The class drop off points are outlined below. If you need to contact your teacher, they will be opening the doors at 8.50am every morning. You can also contact via Seesaw or leave a message by telephoning the office.

<u>Nursery-</u> Side gate of nursery outdoor play area. (Enter and Exit)

<u>P1-</u> P1 fire doors at the back of the school. (Enter and Exit)

<u>P2-</u> Line up outside the classroom windows. They will enter through the P2/P3 fire doors. Exit through via the Community Room door which is located at the front of the building beside the bike shelter.

<u>P3-</u> Line up outside the classroom windows. (Enter and Exit)

<u>P4</u>- P4 fire doors at the front playground (Enter and Exit)

<u>P4/5</u>- P4 fire doors at the front playground (Enter and Exit)

<u>P5/6</u>- Community Room doors (Enter and Exit)

<u>P7</u>- Foyer front doors of the school (Enter and Exit)

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is now open to all pupils from Monday 4th September. A note will follow which we are asking parents to complete so as we can prepare for specific numbers. We are encouraging pupils to come to breakfast club everyday as it is a healthy and nutritious start to your child's day.

Price: £1.20 per child

Times: 8.10am-8.50 (last entry 8.30am). The doors will NOT open until 8.10am when supervision will begin. There will be no supervision for your child before this time. Drop off: Fire exit doors at side of hall (back entrance at car park)

Nursery can start Breakfast Club once all groups are settled. Please touch base with Mrs White for more details.
