Moving swiftly from February to March and each month brings with it information regarding new events, updates and diary dates.

To ensure the Health and Safety of our children I would be grateful if the following precautions are adhered to: -

- On icy/frosty/snowy days please use the appropriate gritted pathways around the school.
- All children need to be sent to school with the appropriate outdoor clothing for this time of year. Coats, hats, scarfs, gloves and proper footwear are essential because children are encouraged to play outdoors on dry days.
- Drive very slowly and safely into the school grounds and car park area. Car access to the playground area is <u>not</u> <u>permitted</u>.

At break time we are going to run a "Reading Buddy" scheme where KS2 and KS1 will pair up with Foundation Stage and Nursery children to read to each other. Punctuality



The school day starts at 8:55am and all pupils need to be in line at 8:50am (on the first bell) to ensure they are ready to go into school on the second bell. Sickness

Could parents please note that if your child has vomiting, diarrhoea or running a temperature they must be kept off for 24 hours. This will help stop the spread of infection/sickness throughout the school.
