Boys – blue trousers, light blue polo shirt, blue school jumper, blue/black socks and black shoes


► Girls - blue skirt or pinafore, light blue polo shirt, blue school jumper or cardigan, blue/black socks or blue/black tights and black shoes

We must wash them thoroughly to make sure they are clean.


We must wash them regularly throughout the day. Remember only one person at a time!
